Changed your job?

If you cancelled your membership because you have changed your job or workplace, I would like to inform you that as GMB is a general Union, you can still remain a member, regardless of where you work as we represent workers across a wide range of industries and sectors. You have a legal right to belong to a Trade Union and being a member of GMB means you have access to free legal advice and representation, should you need it at work. Also, in the event of sustaining an injury in the workplace, through no fault of your own, GMB membership provides complete legal cover for personal injury claims at no additional charge. If your new employer does not operate a system which enables you to pay your contributions through your wages, then all you need to do is complete the direct debit mandate on the enclosed application form.

Are you sick, unemployed or on maternity or shared parental leave?

If you have been a member for a year and become unemployed, ill or are on maternity or shared parental leave, you can pay a reduced amount (just 22p a month) to keep your GMB membership and retain any benefits you have accrued (such as being able to access our legal services) but you just won't be eligible for employment support.

Have you retired?

If you have recently retired from work and wish to remain a GMB member, you can apply for free retired life membership within three months of no longer paying contributions. To qualify, you must be permanently retired from paid work, have been a member for at least five years and apply in writing. If you have been a member for less than 5 years, you can pay a one-off charge of £40 for Retired Life Membership. As with many organisations, things can go wrong, but unless the Union is made aware, it is difficult for these to be addressed and for improvements to be made.
